


## Introduction

Visitors may:

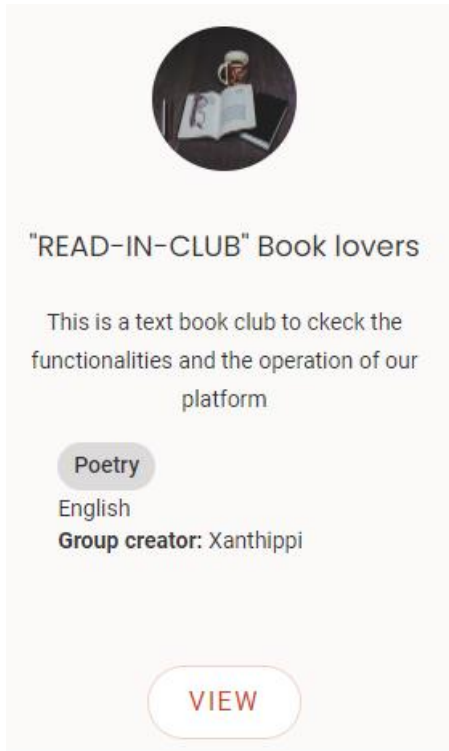
- click on Book Clubs to browse the clubs by clicking on Book Clubs in the main menu. They can filter book clubs by category and language in the left sidebar:

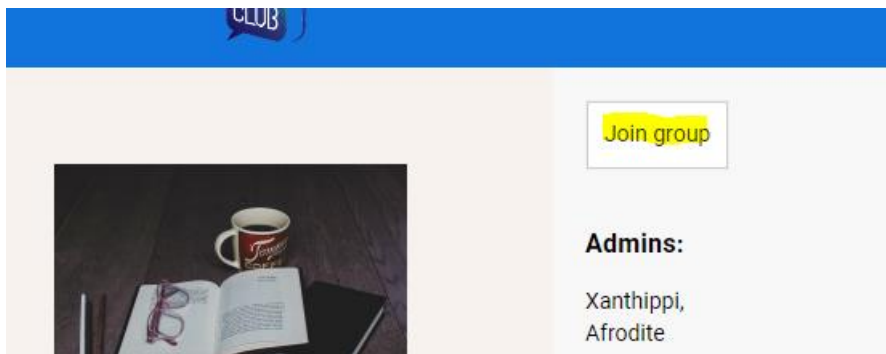

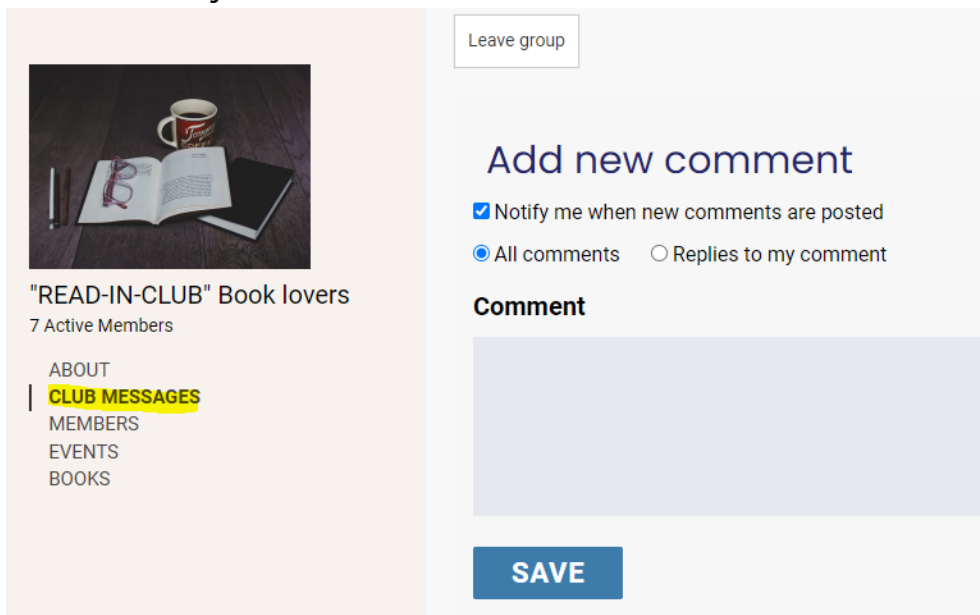

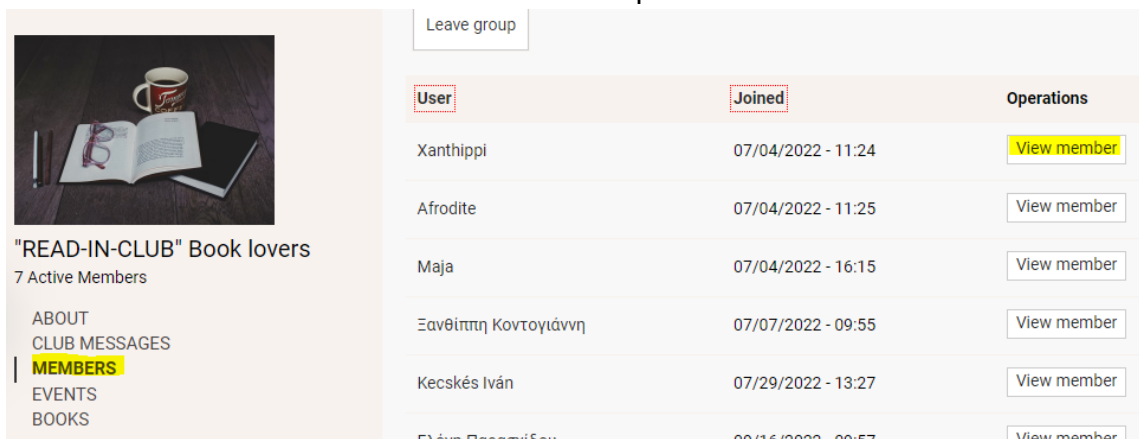
- join the clubs by clicking on the **Join Group** button on the profile page of a club:



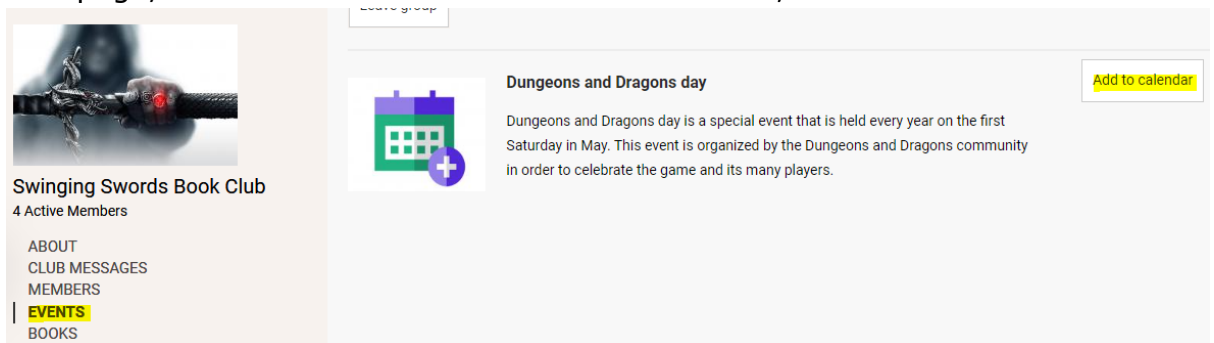
- then click on **Club Messages** in the left sidebar of the club's profile page and read and join the conversations in the clubs:



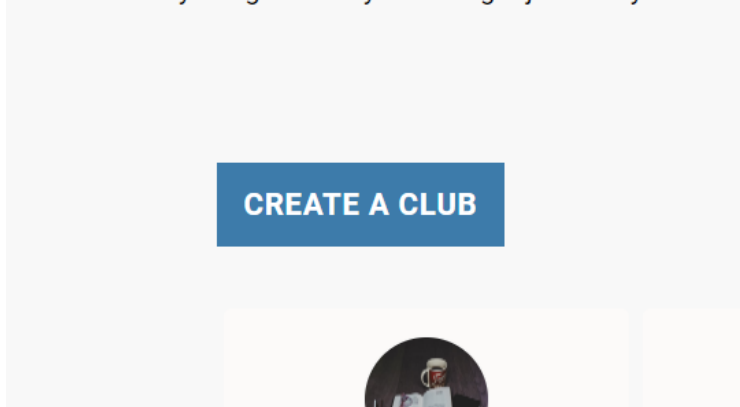
- view the list of the club members by clicking on the **Members** menu in the left sidebar of the club's profile page, then click on the **View member** button next to each member to view their profiles:

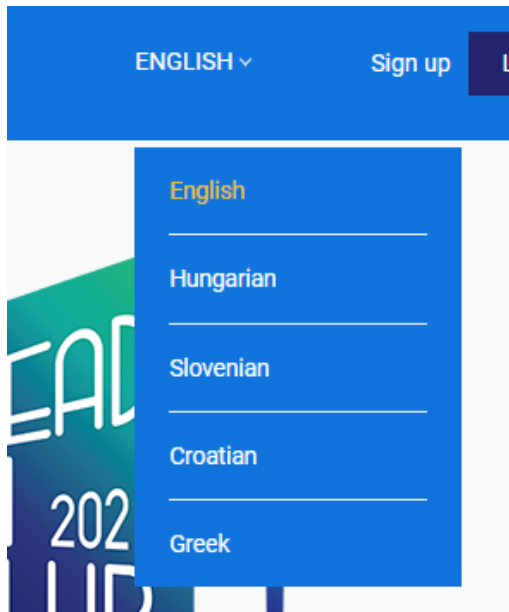

When uploading a book, users create a piece of content within the website. This piece of content has a language. The language of the content will be the language selected in the language selector in the top right corner:



The language of the book itself may be different from the language of the content—the language of the book can be specified when uploading the book, by selecting a language from the **Book's language** drop-down:

The language of the content determines the language in which the book will appear in the list of books when you browse the site.
